


# PETROLEUM COKE DE-WATERING




## **Design Versatility**

General Kinematics Petroleum Coke Dewatering System produces continuous, reliable dewatered flow stream for fast and efficient processing of pet coke. Dewatering units utilize GK's patented dewatering deck technology which eliminates blinding and constant conveyor maintenance. Feeders utilize proven two-mass technology for energy efficient operation. Available as fixed or mobile units depending on your process and application.




#### Pit Side Arrangement

The GK Pet Coke system minimizes bridge crane use. Simply position the bridge over the pit and utilize the trolley to move material back and forth to the GK unit. An overhead clamshell bucket can be used to dump wet Pet Coke into a hopper with grid above the General Kinematics de-watering conveyor. Separated water flows into a sluiceway or back into the pit for recycling. Dry coke is deposited onto a belt conveyor for storage or transfer. Double or triple stacking in the pit is eliminated as well as "flush back" on conveyor belts. The GK dewatering conveyor technology enables dumping of inundated clamshell loads directly onto our dewatering conveyor.



#### **Under Drum Arrangement**

The coking drum discharges through a special double roll crusher to the General Kinematics vibratory de-watering conveyor. Water is returned to the sluiceway as dry coke is transferred on to a belt conveyor to storage.



#### **Hydro Sluiceway Arrangement**

Rail mounted double roll crusher deposits material into a sluiceway which transfers water and coke into a sump. Material is then sent via slurry pump to General Kinematics de-watering system. Water is returned to the labarynth and dry coke is transferred on a belt conveyor to storage.
